After a successful year 2009. Special Olympics Bharat - Goa, started its year with the National Championship in Athletics at Anantapur – Hyderabad from the 8th – 13th January 2010, Special Olympics – Goa, participated at the National Championship in Athletics, and won 8 Gold, 5 Silver & 8 Bronze medals.

There were 24 States from various parts of India, who had participated. In all there were 850 Male & Female participants & 208 Male & Female coaches, respectively. Earlier our state Athletic team underwent 10 days Coaching Camp at Campal grounds

Queen's Baton Relay

The Queen's Baton Relay for the XIX Commonwealth Games 2010 Delhi, was launched at Buckingham palace (London) by her Majesty the Queen on 29th October 2009 . As the Baton started its international journey through the 70 commonwealth nations/countries. The Baton had travelled 1,70,000 km in 240 days before entering India through Wagah border on 25th June 2010. As the Baton passed through every state in India Goa received the Baton on the 7th September and our International Special Olympians from Goa



had the privilege to carry this baton from Old Goa to Panjim the capital city of **Goa**. At Old Goa the Director of Sports and Youth affairs Dr. Susana de Souza praised our special athletes for doing the honours in carrying the Torch . Later the Executive Director of Sports Authority of Goa Mr. V.M. Prabhudessai praised our Special Olympians.

Special Olympics Bharat –Goa had the privilege of introducing Softball in India .

The first Softball training camp was held at Campal Grounds from 10th – 16th November 2010. The participants from various states of India attended this camp, during the five days training all the 50 Trainees stayed at Peace Haven School Caranzalem –Goa ,

Since Special Olympics Bharat was introducing this game for the first time in India .The trainees were trained in the basic rules of softball and how to play the game. After the completion of the training the coaches would have to go back and train another two coaches from their own state

and attend the second training at Hyderabad there were 5 Goan coaches from the various schools of Goa who attended the training. Later the five coaches from Goa attended the second softball training camp at Anantapur –Hyderabad.



BADTE KADAM II CAMPAIGN WAS INAUGURATED IN GOA ON 22nd NOV. 2010.

The National Trust for the welfare of Persons with Autism, cerebral palsy, mental retardation and Multiple disabilities in collaboration with ONGC was organizing a country wide awareness and sensitization campaign on disabilities from 16th to 30th Nov. 2010. This campaign was flagged out on Nov.16, 2010 in New Delhi in collaboration with Special Olympics Bharat . Thereafter programs in various parts of the country was organized by co-ordinating agencies nominated in each of the states from Nov. 19th to 27th 2010. With this campaign the national Trust aims to enhance sensitivity towards issues related to disabilities among the general public as also to create awareness among the affected families about resources available in the entire country. Though

Goa is relatively better placed in the field of disabilities compared to many states in India we would all agree that a lot remains to be done, especially in the rural areas of Goa. The Goa campaign is being co-ordinated by Sangath which is the State Nodal Agency Centre (SNAC) of the National Trust and the disability Rights Association of Goa (DRAG), The Programs was organized in Panjim, Margao, Vasco, Canacona, Bicholim and Pernem from the 22nd to 27th Nov. 2010 in partnership with the local NGO's in the disability sector. The National Trust and Special Olympics Bharat felicitated the Special Olympians from Goa with a Sum of Rupees TwentyFive Thousand .At each of the venues they had a brief cultural programme like a song, a dance or one act play. Each schools had participated in the cultural program by sending a team of students to perform in the cultural program.
