Little Joshua loves the water and has been swimming from the age of two. He has proved to be a natural swimmer and trains regularly at the Peddem swimming pool.



The event will start at Betim Jetty and will end at the Bombay Jetty



(Customs House) which is a distance of 800mts. The Sports Authority of Goa, Marine Police, Traffic Police and the Captain of Ports and other volunteers have kindly come forward to help in organising this event.

On the World Autism Awareness Day, Joshua will attempt this daring feat, hoping to sensitise people all over Goa to a

condition which affects hundreds of thousands of children across the globe, for which scientists do not know the cause nor doctors the cure.
